## Subject terminology

A range of relevant subject terminology will be provided. Students will practise using the terminology to support their ideas, view and analysis.

### **Explicit and implicit language**

Students will identify and interpret explicit and implicit information and ideas from texts. A variety of texts, both literary fiction and non-fiction, will be provided to allow them to select and synthesise information to respond to exam-style questions.

#### Answering exam questions about language

Specific practice of exam-style questions under timed conditions. Through a process of modelling and scaffolding, students will respond to tasks and then review their own progress against mark schemes.

### Achieving effects & influencing readers

Exploration of how language 'works' – beginning with the basics (e.g. adjectives, adverbs) and moving on to specific linguistic techniques. Students will identify, explain and comment on how writers effect their readers.
